	Program Description	In Mexico, Fiestas are a form of national recreation celebrating many different aspects of culture and society. This program challenges learners with different Fiesta dances relating to the theme of life/ death, tying into a focus on the Day of the Dead. During the program, students will learn about and try variations of traditional dances including the "Dance of the Little Old Men" (Los Viejitos), the "Dance of Los Voladores-Dance of the Flyers" as well as creative dance with the "Hand Waving Dance" (a preparation ritual done in cemeteries and at the ofrenda); and the "Skeleton Dance". 		About the presenter: Marc Kotz began dancing and acting in his early teens- over thirty years ago. Since that time he has performed and choreographed internationally. 


